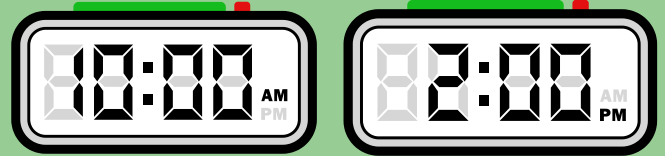

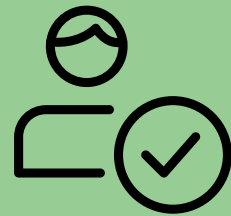


IMPORTANT INFORMATION
